ABOUT MWSO

- Metro Warriors STEM Organization (MWSO) was birthed from a subdivision of Metro Warriors Youth (MWYO) in Washington DC who serves youth in Sports, Health, Fitness and STEM. MWSO officially began in 2013 as a Chapter of the National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE JR.). MWSO a unique Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics year round project based program designed with a mentoring, competition, coaching and professional development component. We started with 5 members in 2011 and 2017-2018 registrations were over 150.
- Our goal is to expose under representative youth (K-12) to STEM activities, learning programs and competitions early and often.

What we do

MWSO provides yearlong summer, after-school and weekend STEM programs that caters to youth
(ages 6-17) in the Washington DC metropolitan area. MWSO headquarters located at the National
Christian Academy, 6700 Bock Road, Fort Washington, Maryland. Classes are administered weekly in
the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS), private schools in Maryland, Prince George's County
and in after-school programs in nontraditional venues.










